- 4. Expand revenue opportunities to ACEP through membership, education, accreditation, or strategic partnerships and represent international interests as new products and services are developed.
- 5. Support the International Emergency Medicine Section to expand recruitment and engagement of ACEP International Ambassadors.
- 6. Review the following policy per the Policy Sunset Review Process:
 - International Development & Promotion of Emergency Medicine

Determine by December 15 if the policy should be reaffirmed, revised, rescinded, or sunsetted. Submit any proposed revisions to the Board for approval by the end of the committee year.
