

- Relating to education and scholarship "academic achievement"


 (of a person) interested in or excelling in scholarly pursuits
- Not of practical relevance; only theoretical interest "the debate has been largely academic"

- "the NIH offers grants to academics for research on approved projects"








Core Faculty

• Core Faculty: All physician faculty members who have a significant role in the education of residents/fellows and who have documented qualifications to instruct and supervise. Core faculty members devote at least 15 hours per week to resident, or 10 hours per week to fellow, education and administration.
